WHERE: Camp Olave: an ocean paradise on the Sunshine Coast.

WHEN: July 7 – 14, 2012

Participants to arrive between 2 - 4 pm on Saturday, July 7
Departure is at 11:00 am on Saturday, July 14

WHO: If you are a Brownie, Guide, Pathfinder or Ranger aged 8 – Rangers, this camp is for you. Come individually, with a friend or as a patrol of up to 5 Brownies or up to 6 Guides or Pathfinders with a Guider. Guiders are welcome to come individually.

COST: \$350.00 per girl which includes HST of \$37.44. Full payment is due with application form. Make cheques payable to Girl Guides of Canada. Postdate the cheque to March 30, 2012. Cheques will not be deposited prior to March 30, 2012.

QUALIFICATIONS: All girls must be members of Girl Guides of Canada – Guides du Canada and have four (4) nights camping experience (need not be consecutive), at Brownie or Girl Guide camps, by June 1, 2012

HEALTH FORMS: Include a current completed health form for each participant with the application forms. Each participant must also travel with a copy of their health form.

Remember Camp Olave is a large campsite and there will be considerable walking to and from activities.
