

CAMP OLAVE GARBAGE AND RECYCLING

General Information

1. All refuse containers are behind the garage.
2. An adult must always go with the girls when disposing of any garbage or recycling as the bin lids are heavy, and to make sure the correct container is used.
3. **BE BEAR AWARE.** All garbage **MUST** be removed from your site nightly to reduce your site's attraction to bears. If possible, remove it after each meal. When garbage is on your site it should be kept inside a building.

Garbage – MUST be bagged before placing in dumpster. Secure dumpster lids afterwards.
If dumpster is locked, the key is on the back wall (exterior) of the garage. **BRING YOUR OWN GARBAGE BAGS.**

Cardboard/Recycling Bin – For all items that are permitted as recyclables – see list below. These all go in the same bin but all items other than cardboard must be bagged in a clear plastic bag. **BRING YOUR OWN CLEAR PLASTIC BAGS.**

Cardboard eg. grocery, cracker & cereal boxes, and paper.

- **Flatten** cardboard before putting it in the bin.
- **NO** waxed cardboard.
- **NO** pizza boxes or any cardboard/paper with food traces.
- **NO** paper crafts with glue or sparkles.

Recycling – Pack your recyclables in a **CLEAR** plastic bag (bring your own), tie the bag and just drop the bag in the cardboard/recycling bin.

- All recyclables must be **CLEAN** with no traces of food – wash thoroughly, (a quick rinse **WILL NOT DO**).
- If in doubt whether an item is recyclable or not, toss it into the Garbage, do **NOT** contaminate the recycling.

What CAN be recycled?

Tin Cans – Wash well, put loose lid in can & pinch closed.

Pop cans & Tetra packs - Empty, remove straws & rinse (or take home for a refund).

Foil pie plates – Remove all food traces & wash thoroughly.

Cereal & cracker boxes and similar **unwaxed** boxes – Flattened.

Paper egg cartons (NO Styrofoam cartons)

Newspapers & flyers

Paper – but **NO** paper crafts with glue or sparkles.

Plastic bottles, plastic jars, plastic jugs, & lids – Wash well. Check they have the recycling triangle on them.

What CANNOT be recycled?

Glass products of any kind (take these home for your blue box)

Food waste and take –out food containers of any type

Styrofoam containers or products

Waxed cardboard

Aluminum foil and foil bags such as chip bags

Wood products

Paints and batteries

Clothing
