

CAMP OLAVE GARBAGE & RECYCLING

General Information

- 1. All refuse containers are behind the garage.
- 2. An adult must always go with the girls when disposing of any garbage or recycling as the bin lids are heavy, and to make sure the correct bin is being used.
- 3. BE BEAR AWARE. All garbage MUST be removed from your site nightly to reduce your site's attraction to bears. If possible, remove it after each meal. When garbage is on your site it should be kept inside a building.

GARBAGE BIN


- MUST be bagged before placing in dumpster.
- Secure dumpster lids afterwards.
- If dumpster is locked, the key is on the back wall (exterior) of the garage.
- BRING YOUR OWN GARBAGE BAGS.



CARDBOARD/RECYCLING BIN

- MUST BE LOOSE, DO NOT USE PLASTIC BAGS FOR THIS BIN.
- For all items that are permitted as recyclables see list below.
- These all go in the same bin but all items mustbeloose
- Plastic bags are <u>not</u> permitted in the cardboard/recycling bin.

Cardboard – e.g., grocery, cracker & cereal boxes and paper



- NO waxed cardboard
- NO pizza boxes or any cardboard/paper with food traces
- NO paper crafts with glue or sparkles

Recycling - Must be deposited in the bin loose

- All recyclables must be CLEAN with no traces of food
- Must be washed thoroughly (quick rinses WILL NOT DO)
- If in doubt whether an item is recyclable or not, toss it into the garbage or take it home with you. Do not contaminate the recycling.

CAN BE RECYCLED:

- Tin cans wash well, put lose lid in can & pinch closed.
- Pop cans & tetra packs Empty, remove straws & rinse (or take home for refund)
- Foil pie plates thoroughly washed with no food traces
- Flattened cereal & cracker boxes & similar unwaxed boxes
- Paper egg cartons (NO styrofoam cartons)
- Newspapers & flyers
- Paper but NO paper crafts with glue and sparkles
- Plastic bottles, plastic jars, plastic jugs & lids with recycling triangle thoroughly washed

CANNOT BE RECYCLED:

- Plastic bags of any kind, plastic film or cellophane
- Food waste & take-out food containers of any type
- Styrofoam containers or products
- Waxed cardboard
- Aluminum foil & foil bags such as chip bags
- Wood products, paints, batteries, clothing
- Glass
